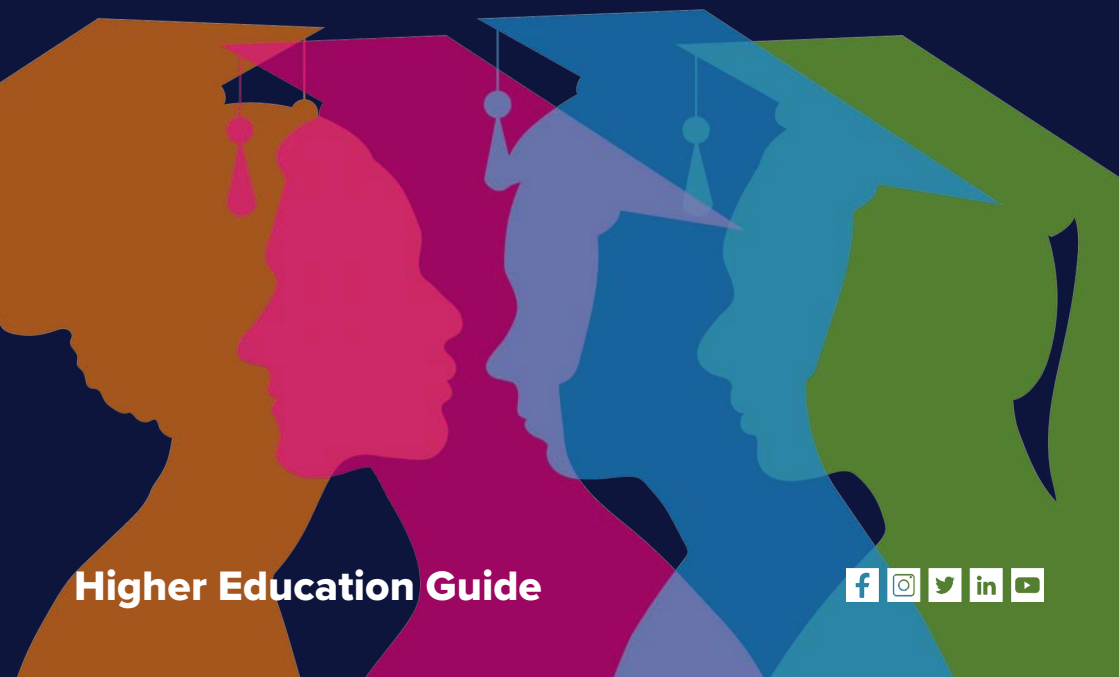

Teacher Training

Do you aspire to be a teacher in the further education (FE) and skills sector? Do you have a passion for your industry and want to share this to help to shape the careers of young people and adults?

If you are already working as a trainer, teacher or volunteer in the sector and want to achieve a nationally-recognised teaching qualification, this course could be the one for you. It is a Post-Compulsory Education and Training (PCET) programme awarded by Staffordshire University and therefore, if you successfully complete, you will have a university verified qualification.

There are two ways to apply:

1. For full time courses apply through UCAS. Visit www.ucas.com to register.
2. For part time courses you need to apply directly to the University by using the links on the relevant course page or visiting southstaffs.ac.uk/higher-education for more information.

When applying through UCAS you will need to have the following information to hand:

- The institution code - Staffordshire University: S72 or The University of Wolverhampton: W75
- The campus code: Staffordshire University: U /or The University of Wolverhampton: R
- The UCAS course code, e.g W370. You'll find these in this guide next to the course of your choice.

You should submit your application to UCAS by their set deadline, which can be found on their website: www.ucas.com. If you miss this deadline, don't worry as applications for undergraduate courses can still be accepted following this date through UCAS extra and clearing - just give us a call and we can help guide you through the application process.

Student Finance



Wondering how to cover the cost of your studies?
We've provided an overview of your options below.

Tuition fee loans and 19+ advanced learner loans:

- Available for full-time and part-time students.
- Covers the cost of your tuition fees in full and is paid directly to us.
- Available to everyone, regardless of financial circumstances or employment status.
- Repayments won't commence until you earn over the threshold salary.
- The amount you pay back will depend on what you earn after your graduate.

Maintenance loans

Higher Level Apprenticeships

As a Higher Level Apprentice you could work for a company, receiving on-the-job training whilst studying towards a qualification on the side. Your apprenticeship would combine work with study and may include a work-based, academic or combined qualification or a professional qualification relevant to the industry.

- **Level 4** apprenticeships are equivalent to the first year of an undergraduate degree, or a Higher National Certificate (HNC).
- **Level 5** apprenticeships are equivalent to a foundation degree, or a Higher National Diploma (HND).
- If you want to gain further qualifications, you can go on to complete a degree apprenticeship – the equivalent to an undergraduate or master's degree.

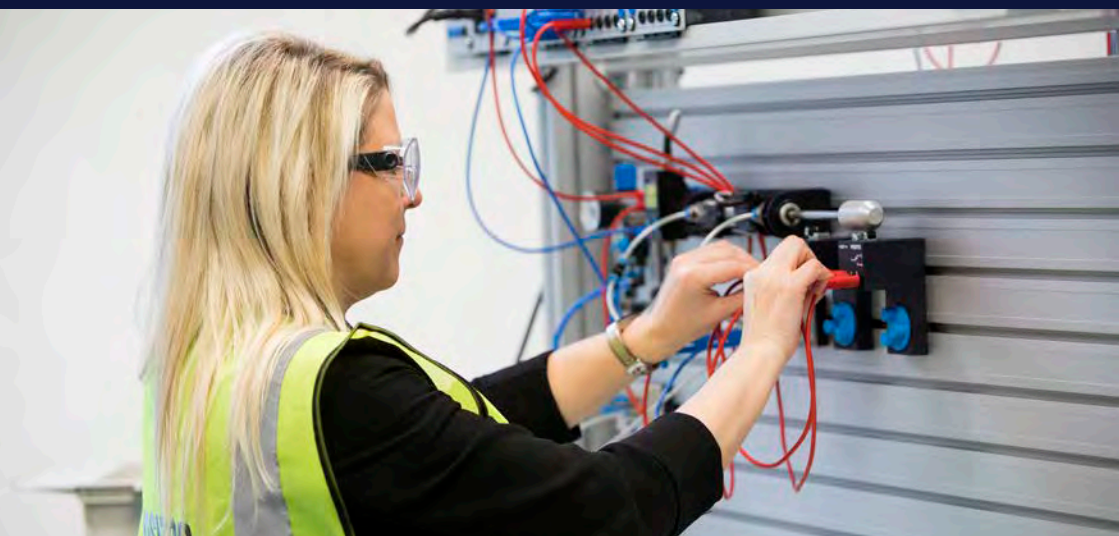

Advanced Engineering Manufacture Apprenticeship

Do you want to be responsible for the quality, safety and delivery of manufactured products or services, ensuring they are delivered to the customer on time at the agreed cost?

Learn how to provide specialist technical support for engineers, so that organisations can develop, produce or test new/existing products, processes, or procedures to meet a customer specification in terms of quality, cost and delivery, as efficiently and effectively as possible.

You will gather information and data from a range of sources and analyse it, make decisions, solve problems and produce and/or update technical documentation, reports and specifications. You would be responsible for the delivery, quality and accuracy of the work you complete, using a range of tools and techniques to support decision making and problem solving.

Network Engineer Apprenticeship

Do you want learn the core knowledge, skills and behaviours to allow you to be responsible for supporting a Network Engineer function?

The primary role of a network engineer is to design, install, maintain and support communication networks within an organisation or between organisations.

Network engineers need to maintain high levels of operation of communication networks in order to provide maximum performance and availability for their users, such as staff, clients, customers and suppliers. They will understand network configuration, cloud, network administration and monitoring tools, and be able to give technical advice and guidance.

As an apprentice you will work alongside experienced, skilled staff, gain job-specific skills and training, and earn a wage and get holiday pay whilst you train.

Software Developer Apprenticeship

Do you want to learn to be a logical and creative thinker, with problem solving skills? Do you approach things in a thorough and organised way?

A software developer builds and tests simple, high-quality code across front end, logic and database layers. A developer will typically be working as part of a larger team, in which they will have responsibility for some of the straightforward elements of the overall project.

The developer will need to be able to interpret design documentation and specifications. The customer requirements will typically be defined and agreed by more experienced or specialist members of the team, such as a business analyst or technical architect.

This course will help develop those analytical and problem solving skills, using your initiative and taking responsibility.

Operations Manager Apprenticeship

Do you want to develop skills in management, communication, finance and team leading while creating and delivering operational plans and managing projects?

This course is suitable for those who manage a team or projects, and wish to achieve operational or departmental goals and objectives. They are accountable to a more senior manager or business owner.

Working in the private, public or third sector and in all sizes of organisation, specific responsibilities and job titles will vary, but the knowledge, skills and behaviours needed will be the same. Key responsibilities may include creating and delivering operational plans, managing projects, leading and managing teams, managing change, financial and resource management, talent management, coaching and mentoring.

Level 4 Qualifications



Accountancy

Do you want a career in accountancy? Are you ready to work towards an internationally recognised qualification to help launch your career?

A professional qualification like AAT can set you on track to a range of future job opportunities, whether in bookkeeping, accountancy, auditing, tax or self-employment.

Throughout the duration of the course, students will complete both mandatory and optional units. These units will cover a variety of different areas that are associated with accounting, enabling students to widen their knowledge and skills in these areas.
