

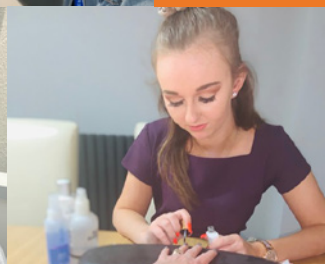

Your finances

As a student, you may be eligible for financial support. Studying at college, including apprenticeships, is fully funded for those aged 16-18. If you're 19+ your course may also be free if you are eligible; further funding is available for adults through the government's free courses for jobs scheme. Additional funding support may be available to help cover the cost of things like travel and college materials.

As an apprentice you'll spend your time divided between working at your employer and undertaking training at, or supported by, the college to develop the knowledge, skills and professional behaviours required for the job role. An impartial assessment, called an end-point assessment, will check that you have gained the knowledge, skills and behaviours needed for the workplace.

You will be assessed on the job at work. The majority of your learning will be delivered in the workplace and is designed to be flexible.



You can complete your English and maths functional skills at college or online.



Apprenticeships are available at various levels, so regardless of existing qualifications or experience, there will be an opportunity here for you.

Take your career to the next level ...T-LEVEL!

Are you a school leaver aged 16 - 19? Do you want to get valuable experience in the workplace whilst studying for your course? **T-Levels** could be an option for you!

Equivalent to 3 A levels, a T-Level focuses on vocational skills and includes an industry placement of at least 45 days. T-Level students spend 80% of their course in their learning environment and 20% in their industry placement, where they can put their skills into action.
