Advanced learner loan

If you are aged 19+, you could take advantage of an advanced learner loan to cover the cost of your course. You will start repaying only once you start earning over £25,000 per year.

If you apply for a level 2 course or below and receive eligible benefits, you may qualify for a FREE course.

Claiming Jobseeker's allowance

People receiving
Jobseeker's Allowance
(JSA), Employment and
Support Allowance

(including housing
benefit, income support
and working tax credits)
may be eligible for a
FREE course.

Aged 19 - 23

Your course is FREE if you are enrolling for your first level 1 or 2 qualification and are aged 19-23.

Earning less than £20,319 per year

If you are employed and earning less than £20,319 p/a, your course may be FREE.

As an apprentice you'll spend your time divided between working at your employer and undertaking training at, or supported by, the college to develop the knowledge, skills and professional behaviours required for the job role. An impartial assessment, called an end-point assessment, will check that you have gained the knowledge, skills and behaviours needed for the workplace.
