Ways to pay

Advanced learner loan

As an adult aged 19+, you could take advantage of an advanced learner loan to cover the cost of your course. You will start repaying only once you start earning over £25,000 per year.

Your course may be FREE if you are:

Unemployed/claiming benefits

If you apply for a Level 2 course or below and receive eligible benefits, you may qualify for a FREE course.

Claiming Jobseeker's allowance

People receiving JSA, ESA or UC (including housing benefit, income support and working tax credits) may be eligible for a FREE course.

Aged 19 - 23

Your course may be FREE if you are enrolling for your first Level 1 or 2 qualification.

Your course may be FREE

If you are employed and earning less than £25,750 or £34,194 p/a for WMCA residents.

Bursary support

If your income is less than £35,000 p/a you may be eligible for support.

Free courses

If you are aged 19+ you could access a course for free, as part of the support available from the government to help you gain the skills you need to get the job you want, whatever your stage of life.

The free courses include Level 3 qualifications, and the government pays the course fees. For more information please get in touch.


